### 1, TOKYO MORNING

#### **Tokyo Tower**

Enjoy a panoramic view of Tokyo from its main observatory.

#### **Imperial Palace Plaza**

Short photo stop at the outer garden of the Palace.

#### **Akihabara and Ueno(Drive through)**

##### **Akihabara**

Electric appliances and computers discount shopping center.

##### **Ueno**

Noted for its park and market area "Ameyoko" for bargain shopping.

#### **Asakusa Kannon Temple and Nakamise Shopping Street**

The oldest and most popular temple in Tokyo. A promenade section called Nakamise-dori is basically both sides of narrow, paved entranceway to the temple crammed with tiny food and souvenir shops.

#### **Ginza Shopping District(Drive through)**

The most celebrated shopping and amusement area.

#### **Tasaki Pearl Gallery**

See the process of pearl cultivation. One lucky participant will be presented with a pearl.

#### **National Diet Building (Drive by)**

The Japanese Capitol (the House of Parliament).

#### **Imperial Palace East Garden**

This is where you'll find what's left of the central keep of old Edo Castle (the stone foundation).

Take a stroll in one of the vast inner gardens of the Imperial Palace.

(on Mon. and Fri. when the garden is closed ,visit the Imperial Palace Plaza instead)

#### **Asakusa Kannon Temple and Nakamise Shopping Street**

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#### **Ginza Shopping District.**

The most celebrated shopping and amusement area. Tour disbands on arrival at Ginza.
